Both residents and numerous visitors perceive Ljubljana as a city made to the measure of man. Ljubljana is classified as a mid-sized European city, but it has preserved its small-town friendliness and relaxed atmosphere while providing all the facilities of a modern capital. It is a very unique city dotted with pleasant picturesque places where you can expect all kinds of nice little surprises. Ljubljana has preserved evidence of a five thousand year history including, among others, the remains of the Roman city of Emona and the old city centre with its medieval castle, Baroque façades, decorative portals and uneven roofs. Other significant bits of the city mosaic are picturesque bridges across the Ljubljanica river and the vast Tivoli park, which stretches into the very city centre.

GETTING TO SLOVENIA

BY AIR:

Direct scheduled flights from/to major European cities: Frankfurt, London, Paris, Zurich, Munich, Berlin, Amsterdam, Brussels, Budapest, Copenhagen, Moscow, Vienna, Prague, Sarajevo, Belgrade, Warsaw, Rome, Barcelona, Helsinki...

Ljubljana is 25 km away from Ljubljana Airport.

BY TRAIN

Connections abroad are also excellent. You can come to Slovenia on direct lines from Italy, Austria, Hungary and Croatia. Train travel is convenient and inexpensive. The main railway and bus station is only 400 m away from the hotel.

BY CAR

You can reach Slovenia via one of the border crossings with Italy, Austria, Hungary or Croatia, or you can rent a car in one of our car rental agencies. The hotel is easy to access from all of the city's major roads; once in the city, you simply follow the blue hotel signs.

TOURIST ACTIVITIES IN SLOVENIA

You can combine attending the conference with a beautiful holiday in Slovenia. Slovenia is a country in southern Central Europe and offers tourists a wide variety of landscapes in a small space: Alpine in the northwest, Mediterranean in the southwest, Pannonian in the northeast and Dinaric in the southeast.

Slovenia has good traffic connections. In just over an hour's drive from the hotel you can take a walk along the enchanting Slovenian coast and visit the medieval town of Piran; it takes even less time to reach Lake Bled with its world-famous island in the middle, to explore the magnificent underground world of the Karst, or to enjoy the winter fairytales offered at Slovenia's ski resorts.
